In May 2011, the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection released the emergency operator training regulations [310 CMR 80](#) for owners and operators of applicable underground storage tank (UST) systems.



Frequently Asked Questions

1. I have USTs: does this apply to me?

- ✓ **Yes** if you store petroleum products for **fleet fueling or emergency power**
- ✗ **No** if you store petroleum products **exclusively** for heating.

2. What do I have to do?

- > You must develop a staffing plan that designates three classes of operators - A, B and C.
- > Your class A & B operators must receive site specific training **and must pass a certification exam** by **August 8, 2012**.
