EPA's Toxic Release Inventory (TRI) Reporting due July 1

UST Operator Regulations Go into Effect on August 8th

As noted in last month's e-mail, the new regulation provides for three classes of operators, A, B and C. In addition to site-specific training, Class A and B operators will be required to pass an examination before the August 8th deadline!
