

### Appendix B.

<u>BWP-IW 39</u> covers specific industrial facilities with sewer connections for discharging greater than 25,000 gpd to Publicly Owned Treatment Works (POTW); also known as sewage treatment plants without Industrial Pretreatment Programs (IPPs). IPPs are industrial sewer discharge permit programs operated by POTWs as required by their federally issued National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit. The Standard Industrial Classification Codes for the industrial facilities that are covered by a BWP-IW 39 are listed in Appendix B."

#### MassDEP Proposes Lower Sulfur Content Limits for Oil Burners

"MassDEP is proposing amendments to 310 CMR 7.00 and 310 CMR 7.05 that would lower the allowable sulfur content of distillate oil (i.e., home heating oil) and residual oil combusted at stationary sources to reduce emissions of sulfur dioxide, which contributes to regional haze and poses direct health impacts."

## UST Operator Regulations Go into Effect on August 8, 2012.

As noted in last month's e-mail, the new regulation provides for three classes of operators, A, B and C. In addition to site-specific training, Class A and B operators will be required to pass an examination before the August 8, 2012 deadline!
