MEMA's New Online Reporting System – 2013 Tier II Reports Due by March 1

The Massachusetts Emergency Management Agency (MEMA) has adopted a new online reporting system, Tier II Manager, for Tier II reports filed in 2014 and after. <u>Click here</u> for the online filing system. All Tier II filers must re-register on the new system, with a limit of one user account per facility. Registration forms are currently available on the website. Previous Tier II data for filers from the 2011 and 2012 reports was expected to be preloaded into the system by the end of last year to allow for easier 2013 data reporting.

As of 2014, hard copy filings will not be accepted by MEMA; only electronic copies will be accepted. Updates to the new MEMA system will not impact any EPC or local fire department Tier II filing requirements. Massachusetts facilities covered by the federal Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act (EPCRA) requirements must submit Tier II reports to their Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC), the State Emergency Response Commission (SERC), and their local fire department annually. Reporting Year 2013 Tier II Reports are due by March 1, 2014.

EPA Biennial Hazardous Waste Reports Submit by March 1 to Avoid Penalties

Any facility that was a Large Quantity Generator (LQG) or a Treatment, Storage or Disposal Facility (TSDF) during the calendar year of 2013 must complete a Biennial Report for its hazardous waste. Reports must be completed using calendar year 2013 information and submitted to MassDEP by March 1, 2014.

Failure to comply with the reporting requirement – or failure to submit accurate, complete or signed forms – can result in administrative penalties up to \$1,000 per day.



Note that MassDEP now requires electronic compilation of the Biennial Report via the free BRState software issued by Florida DEP or any other BR software package that can generate EPA Flat File format outputs. Every report should consist of a data disk and signed paper SI form - that's it; paper reports will not be accepted unless by prior approval.
